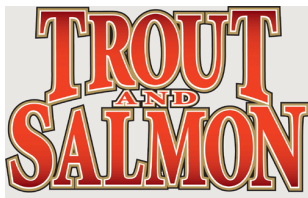

Atlantic Salmon Magic is some 463 pages long and the writing is spare and considered. For all its beautiful pictures and thoughtful diagrams, at its heart it's a good read. Browne addresses the key issues that have puzzled salmon fishers for generations: why does a salmon take a fly? What does a salmon see? He offers answers and sometimes challenges the theories of greats such as Wood and Falkus.

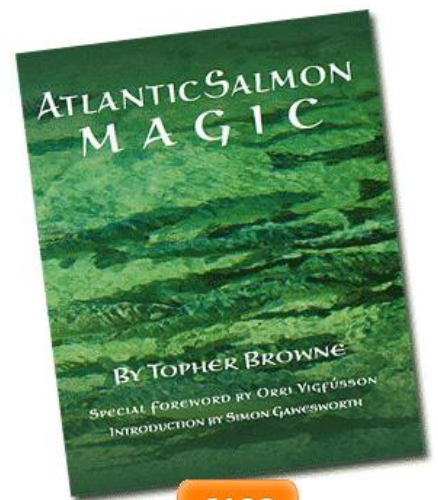

A leather-bound numbered and signed limited edition of the book is also available at £450 (with £150 going to salmon charities).

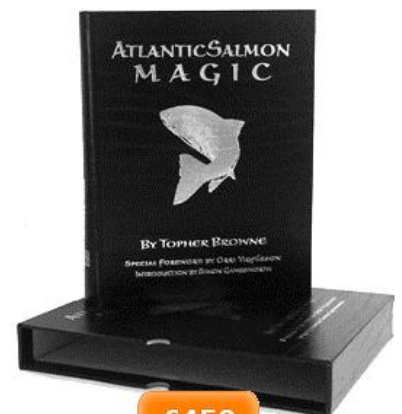
